The event aims to create a platform for young scholars to present their research, exchange ideas, and engage in academic discussion in the field of historical studies.

The conference welcomes both theoretical and empirical contributions that explore historical processes and phenomena from ancient times to the present day.

Thematic areas include:

- History of Ukraine
- Archaeology
- World History
- Religious Studies
- Theory and Methods of Teaching History

We look forward to welcoming young researchers and creating a stimulating environment for scholarly dialogue.

Participation format: offline and online (via the Zoom/ Google meet platform). Invitations with access details will be sent to participants prior to the conference.

Participation fee: participation in the conference is free of charge. All participants will receive certificates.

Accepted conference papers will be published in the conference proceedings. The publication will be available electronically in the university's institutional repository.

Conference languages: Ukrainian, English, and Polish.



Submission procedure:

To participate in the conference, applicants are required to:

1. Complete the **online registration form** by **May 1, 2026**: <https://forms.gle/MV338RZGAXC7wY9z7>
2. Submit the conference paper (file name format: *Paper_LastName*) (see Appendix 1) to nvolik@tnpu.edu.ua by **May 10, 2026**.

Formatting Guidelines for Conference Papers

1. Conference Paper must be prepared on **A4 paper** and submitted as a **.doc or .docx file**.
2. **Margins:** 2 cm on all sides.
3. **Paragraph indent:** 1 cm.
4. **Line spacing:** single.
5. **Font:** Times New Roman, 12 pt.
6. **Hyphenation:** not permitted.
7. **Page numbering:** not required.
8. **Figures and tables:** should be placed immediately after the paragraph where they are first mentioned or on the following page. All figures must include captions, and tables must have headings. The font size for table text should be **10–12 pt Times New Roman**. Landscape orientation for figures and tables is not permitted.
9. **References:** sources cited in the text should be indicated in square brackets, for example [1, p. 25]. The reference list should be placed at the end of the Paper and arranged in the order in which the sources appear in the text.
10. **Length of the Paper:** 3–6 pages.

Structure of the Conference Paper

1. **Title of the Conference Paper** (in capital letters, bold).
2. **Author's name and surname** (bold); **scientific adviser's name and surname**, academic degree, academic title, and position; **name of the institution** (place of study or work); **contact details of the author** (phone number and mailing address for correspondence).
3. **Main text.**
4. **Conclusions.**
5. **References.**
